

Non-Subpoena Policy

This policy serves as an agreement between the interested parties that no party shall attempt to subpoena their provider(s) testimony or their provider(s) records for a deposition or court hearing of any kind for any reason.

All parties acknowledge that the goal of psychotherapy and psychiatric medication management is the amelioration of psychological distress and interpersonal conflict, and that the process of psychotherapy and psychiatric medication management is dependent on trust and openness during the appointments attended.

Therefore, it is understood by all parties that if they request their provider(s) services as a psychotherapist or psychiatric medication provider, they are expected not to use the information given to them during the progression of their appointment for their own legal purposes or against any of the other parties in a court or judicial setting of any kind.
